Dear Customers,

The coronavirus pandemic has imposed rules on us that make operation of a swimming pool very difficult. But with your help, we still want to attempt to make the pools available to the greatest extent possible. Please do your part to help keep the pools open by following all the rules. Please be mindful of each other and act responsibly, for your sake as well as ours, as the situation remains serious. Please follow our supplementary house rules and swimming regulations. ### **Supplementary house rules and swimming regulations for swimming at the Sternbusch pool in a pandemic**

#### **Preamble**

These supplementary rules apply in addition to the house rules and swimming regulations for the Sternbusch pool of 24 September 2019, and are binding. They modify and supplement the house rules and swimming regulations. These supplementary and modifying terms and conditions incorporate regulatory and standard rules that address infection control during the current pandemic phase. Bäderbetriebe Kleve GmbH is making every effort to reopen the Sternbusch pool during a weakening pandemic and to enable it to be used to an extent compatible with the interests of visitors, having due regard to further official determinations. In doing so, further transmission must be avoided. The measures implemented by the pool operator are intended to prevent the risk of infection as far as possible. To achieve the aim of allowing use of the pool, while at the same time preventing infection of users, it is vital that pool users also exercise personal responsibility - towards themselves and others - by complying with the house rules and bathing regulations and these supplementary rules. The staff of Bäderbetriebe Kleve GmbH will monitor the behaviour of pool users and, if necessary, take action on the basis of the house rules. Bäderbetriebe Kleve GmbH cannot provide full monitoring and is therefore dependent on acceptance of the posted rules by all users.

In accordance with the new Coronavirus Protection Ordinance, access to the Sternbusch pool will be possible only with a negative rapid test, as well as for fully vaccinated and recovered persons. School-age children and adolescents with a student ID card are deemed tested based on their participation in mandatory school testing. School-age children and adolescents under 15 years can also present another document showing their age instead of their student ID card. Without this further evidence is required, this can be a negative test or evidence of immunization (fully vaccinated or recovered individuals). Children up to school age are regarded as tested persons without having to take a coronavirus test.

#### Note

- Rapid test or self-test – Certified test administration must be no more than 48 hours ago
- Fully vaccinated – 14 days after the final vaccination (vaccination certificate)
- Recovered persons – Official certificate of recovery

### **I. General rules and conduct in the pool**

(1) No liability for loss can be accepted if swim bags are taken to the edge of the pool.

(2) Unlike the previous rules, according to section II(3) of the house rules and swimming regulations, children up to the age of 10 are required to be accompanied by an adult.

(3) The pool border is only to be accessed immediately before use and left quickly after use of the pool.

(4) After use, users must leave the swimming pool immediately. Crowds outside the door, at public transport stops and in the parking lot are to be avoided as far as possible.

(5) The instructions of staff or other authorised persons must be followed.

(6) Users who breach these supplementary house rules and swimming regulations may be directed to leave the pool.

(7) If parts of the pool cannot be used, information about this will be provided in the entrance area or at the cash desk and on the website "[www.sternbuschbad.de](http://www.sternbuschbad.de)".

## **II. General hygiene measures**

(1) Please only visit the pools if you are feeling well. Persons with a known/proven infection with the coronavirus are not permitted to enter. This also applies to pool users with suspicious symptoms.

(2) Wash your hands frequently and thoroughly with soap (hand hygiene). In particular, wash your hands before entering the swimming pool.

(3) Use the hand disinfection stations, particularly in areas (e.g. in the entrance area) where hand washing is not possible.

(4) Cough and sneeze into a tissue or into the crook of your arm (cough and sneeze etiquette).

(5) Shower before using the pool and wash thoroughly with soap (provided the showers are open). Maintain a distance of at least 1.5 metres from others while showering.

(6) Medical masks must be worn in the designated areas in accordance with official regulations.

(7) The increased hygiene requirements for cleaning and disinfection in all areas can be met by staff. To facilitate compliance, chairs, tables and couches are not provided.

The supplementary house rules and swimming regulations for swimming at the Sternbusch pool in a pandemic will be put into effect or revoked by management by means of a separate notice.
